

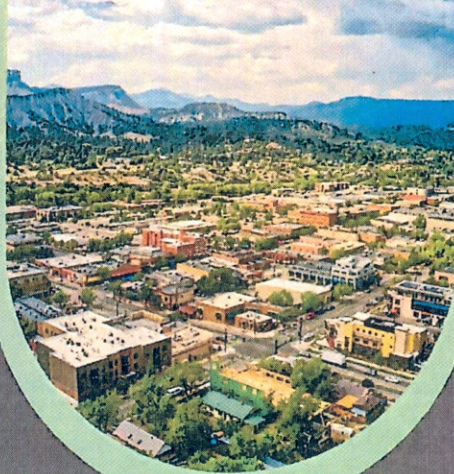
## About Us

Colorado Legal Services is Colorado's **statewide nonprofit legal aid program providing civil legal assistance**—which does not include criminal or traffic matters—to low-income individuals and seniors throughout the state.

Our 13 offices provide **free legal assistance** in a broad variety of legal areas, including family law; eviction defense; consumer protection; services to survivors of serious crime, including human trafficking, and many others.

Colorado Legal Services' focus is to enforce and defend clients' legal rights to meet their basic human needs, including shelter, safety, food, health, and income.

Colorado Legal Services may provide legal advice, brief services or full representation—depending on client needs and the organization's resources. In certain instances, cases may be referred to clinics or other agencies for additional help. Services are provided in a client's primary language.

## Who do we help?

**Those facing housing instability:** Housing law matters, including evictions, foreclosure, landlord/tenant issues, and others.

**Families:** Family law matters including civil protection orders, divorce, custody, guardianship, and others.

**Coloradans who need identification documents:** We serve people who need identification documents through our ID Project. IDs are required for housing, work, and various benefits.

**Consumers:** Consumer/debt issues, including bankruptcy, garnishment, collection, repossession, and others.

**Foreign survivors of crime:** Victim Based Immigration applications for foreign national survivors of crime including survivors of human trafficking and domestic violence, among other U visa qualifying crimes.

**Coloradans facing tax challenges:** Tax controversy representation, including Tax Court litigation, income tax collection defense, exam and audit defense, and income tax related identity theft, among other matters

**Older Coloradans and those having problems with government benefits:** Problems with programs like Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid, SSI, and others.

**Migrant farmworkers:** Education, advocacy, and legal representation for farm workers throughout Colorado.

## Who qualifies for help?

You may qualify for free civil legal aid if you meet income requirements, or if you are 60 years old or older.

Colorado Legal Services does not provide help in criminal cases (except for criminal record sealing), in traffic disputes, or in fee-generating cases such as auto accidents, personal injury, and workers' compensation.

## What if you don't qualify for help?
